



PRECAUTIONARY WATER BOIL ADVISORY LIFTED

Meadow Vista Subdivision & Surrounding Areas
EFFECTIVE: Monday, March 11, 2026 – 11:23 a.m.

The Camino Real Regional Utility Authority (CRRUA) has officially removed the Precautionary Boil Water Advisory for residents in the Meadow Vista subdivision and surrounding areas.

WHAT DOES THIS MEAN?

This advisory was a component of our **Proactive Safety Protocol**, implemented during large-scale infrastructure repairs to provide an extra layer of protection for our residents. Independent laboratory results now confirm that the water system is in full compliance with all New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) and federal drinking water standards. No contamination was detected at any point; this concludes the precautionary period.

INSTRUCTIONS TO RESIDENTS:

Now that the advisory is lifted, residents should take the following standard steps to refresh their home plumbing:

- **Flush Pipes:** Run cold water taps for 3–5 minutes.
- **Ice Makers:** Discard any ice made during the advisory period and clean the unit according to manufacturer instructions.
- **Water Filters:** If you use a water filter, consider replacing the cartridge as a routine maintenance step.

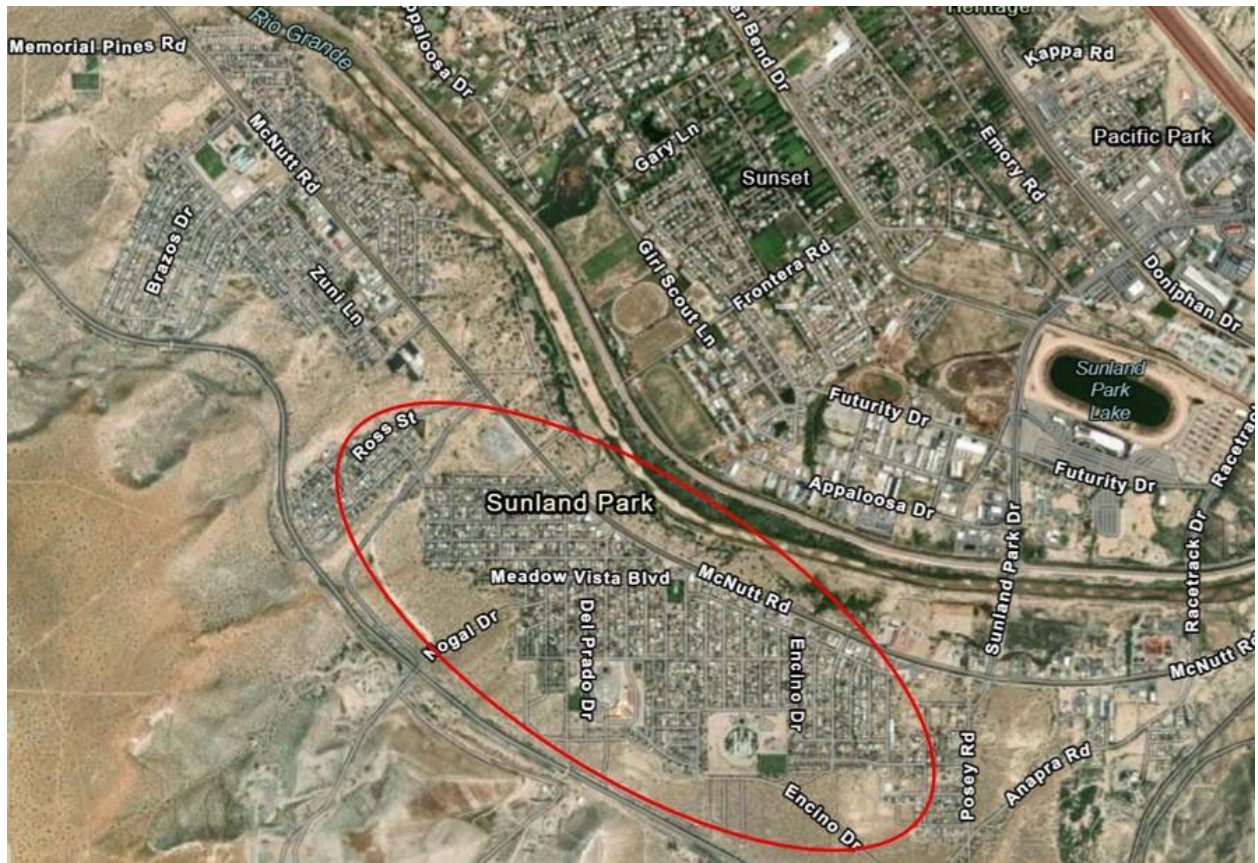
