He suggested that CRRUA writes all the improvements on the next newsletter and give customers water and wastewater system back ground history. Mrs. Susan Yturralde expressed her gratitude for the promptly manner CRRUA employees took to fix a water pressure problem at Santa Teresa Country Club .

Mr. Juan Massey, Consultant, brought the board members up to date on the Legislative session. Mr. Brent Westmoreland, CRRUA Executive Director, informed the board members that the Sunland Park arsenic treatment plant has been down for more than a year. All the plumbing and injectors had been replaced. The pump will be replace Thursday and the plant will be up and running by next Monday or Tuesday. Regarding the arsenic plant at the west mesa, it has been down for six months due to a valve problem. The valve was ordered and JCH will replace it. The arsenic plants will be up and running by the end of the month. The new arsenic treatment plant will be up and running by July it is under construction now.
